This meeting will be closed to in person attendance by the public. Due to the COVID 19 pandemic and CDC's recommendation regarding social distancing measures, the public will not be allowed to be physically present at this meeting, but the meeting will be available to members of the public and allow for two-way communications for those desiring to participate. Telephonic and videoconferencing capabilities will be utilized to allow individuals to address the Corporation. Emails may also be submitted.
