

AGENDA – MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING OF THE NASSAU BAY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO BE HELD ON MONDAY, APRIL 25, 2022 AT 5:00 PM IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, 1800 SPACE PARK DRIVE, SUITE 200, NASSAU BAY, TEXAS.

Portions of this agenda item may be conducted by videoconference whereby a quorum is present at the regular posted location when the matter arises on the agenda and any member who participates remotely strictly complies with the requirements of Texas Government Code Section 551.127 a-1, including the use of video and audio feed of the remote member's participation in the meeting, which audio and video participation must be broadcast live at the meeting. Failure of the member or the equipment to comply with these requirements shall prohibit the remote member's vote from counting.

(Note: This notice is posted because the Nassau Bay Economic Development Corporation partially consists of a quorum of the City of Nassau Bay City Council. When a quorum of a governmental body gathers and deliberates, there must be a posted agenda. It is unlikely that the entire Council shall attend. This posting is a legal necessity and a precaution. Do not confuse this notice or this meeting with a regular or special meeting of the Nassau Bay City Council.)

The Economic Development Corporation reserves the right to meet in closed session on any of the below items should the need arise and if applicable, pursuant to authorization by Title 5, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

A statement of no more than 3 minutes may be made on items of general relevance. There will be no yielding of time to another person. State law prohibits the President and members of the Economic Development Corporation from commenting on any statement or engaging in dialogue without an appropriate agenda item being posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Law. Comments should be directed to the entire Economic Development Corporation, not individual members. Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges and removal from Council Chambers.
