Public Works

- Water Plant Operations: No problems were reported.
- Water meter shut-offs were performed on Thursday, May 3rd.
- Waste Water Operations: No problems were reported.
- Sanitary Sewer Repair: In the 1700 – 1800 block of Antigua, an estimated 400-foot section of sanitary sewer has partially collapsed. An emergency contractor performed a site evaluation and will be submitting a quote for emergency pipe bursting. A section of San Sebastian will be affected during the pipe bursting. Sewer service has not been affected.
- Street repair is completed at Vinland and Antiqua.
- Street Sign Pole Replacements: Crews replaced five (5) rusted stop sign poles. Crews will continue evaluating and replacing when necessary.
- Pot Hole Program: Crews continue filling in pot holes around the City.
- Solar Light Bases: Crews filled in dirt around the bases along the trail.
- Street Eatz Party: Stage has been removed and all equipment was properly stored for the next event.
- Entrance to David Braun Park: Crews are cementing in flag stone at both entrances. Crews will be planting vegetation and installing mulch when completed.
- Park Ruts: Crews are placing sand in ruts located at the parks.
