Administration

- **CCEF Peninsula Cleanup:** Volunteers needed! Clear Creek Environmental Foundation's Annual Clear Creek & Nassau Bay Peninsula Cleanup is Saturday, February 23rd. This cleanup is vital to keeping our waters and the peninsula a clean and safe place for people and wildlife. Each year, volunteers pick up tons of waste, including everything from plastic bottles and paper to washing machines and abandoned boats. No need to sign up in advance, just show up at the Nassau Bay peninsula entrance gate (at 8:30am) to clean the peninsula or at the League City boat ramp at Highway 270 (at 8:00am) to clean up Clear Creek.

Public Works

- There is a minor water leak pending at 1890 Saxony Lane in Queens Court. A supervisor is monitoring and will schedule repair when an exact location of the leak is determined.
- Water Plant Operations: No problems were reported. Electrical work was performed on a main electrical supply support and cabinets.
- CIP Water Tank Painting/Rehabilitation Project: Contractors are welding and continue structural repairs on the tank.
- Park Pavilion Repairs (FEMA): A Notice to Bidders was advertised for structural repairs to the existing David Braun Park pavilion. Sealed Bids will be received until February 21, 2019.
- Nassau Bay Landscape Amenity: The City is currently advertising for construction of a fixed structural landscaping artwork amenity to be located on Nasa Parkway. Sealed bids will be received until February 21, 2019.
- Waste Water Operations: No problems were reported.
- Public Works Building: Shop equipment is being delivered and crews are in the progress of installing between projects. Equipment replacement is a result of FEMA funds after Hurricane Harvey.
- Storm water pump station weekly checks were completed.
- Street lights were repaired in the 18600 block of Martinique Drive.
- A street light was repaired due to three electrical issues at 18600 Cape Town Lane.



- Three (3) palm tree lights were replaced at the 18700 block of Martinique by David Braun Park.
- Tree trimming at Point Lookout and Saxony is in progress.
- Oak tree trimming at NASA Parkway (West Bound) is complete.
- Oak tree trimming at NASA Parkway (East Bound) is in progress.
- Swan Lagoon entrance wall painting in progress. Work is weather pending.
- Swan Lagoon light pole bases were painted (Keep Nassau Bay Beautiful windshield survey item).
- Public Works attended the Southeast Water Purification Plant Operations and Capital Improvements Projects meeting held on January 28th.

Police Department

- UPDATE - Matthew Green, 31-year-old Nassau Bay resident, was arrested on Saturday, January 19th, for criminal trespass on Sea Cove Ct. Green was later released from jail on bond. Green was currently on probation for a previous assault conviction and was arrested a second time on Thursday, January 24th for violation of his probation conditions. As a result of the ongoing investigation, Green was charged on Friday, January 25th with 10 counts of possession of child pornography. Bond for Mr. Green was set at \$15,000 for each possession of child pornography charge, as well as a \$500.00 fine for the probation violation.
