DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Nassau Bay, Texas could be facing the spread of a pandemic flu outbreak or other health emergency resulting from COVID-19 (novel coronavirus).

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Nassau Bay, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect its citizens from a public health threat,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NASSAU BAY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Nassau Bay, Texas, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Nassau Bay, Texas.
3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
