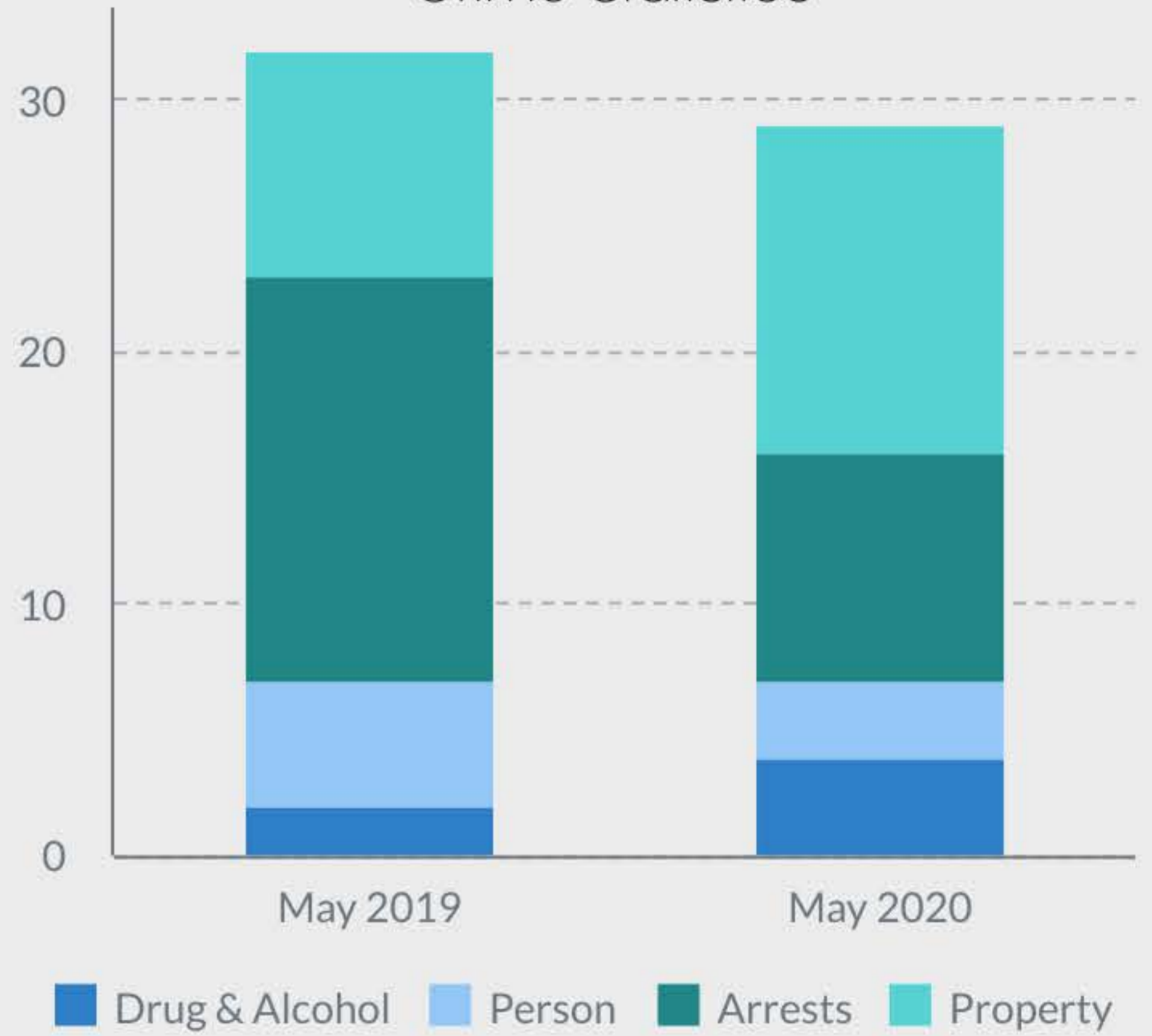

# PUBLIC WORKS

- Water Leak Repairs for the Month of May – Two (2).
- COVID-19 – Parks were reopened on May 1st except for the park playgrounds. The playgrounds re-opened on May 29th.
- CIP Pickleball Court – Construction is in progress.
- Rain Event on May 15th – The City received 3.6 inches.
- Rain Event on May 27th – The City received 3.3 inches.
- A Storm Water Street Project Improvement meeting was held on May 15th.
- Sanitary Sewer Jetting Completed – 1,250 feet of sewer line was jetted to clear debris and increase capacity flow.
- David Braun Park Dog Park – The sidewalk drainage project is complete.
- Storm Water Catch Basins Cleaned and Cleared of Debris – Five (5) times.
- Bids for the sand filter at the WWTP were received and recommendations will be made at the June City Council meeting.
- Palm tree evaluations were completed and submitted to the Public Works Director.
- The storm water lift station was vacuumed out to remove sand and debris.
- Palm Tree Removal – Two (2) dead palm trees.
- Water meters were read for Utility Billing.
- One dead sabal palm tree was removed at Upper Bay Road and Space Park Drive.
- Eleven (11) palm tree lights were replaced on Point Lookout Drive.
- The Upper Bay and Sandy Cove Sanitary Lift Stations were vacuumed out for grease and debris.
- Water line excavation and plugging was completed on the north side of 2045 Space Park. Work was completed due to the impending Dollar General demolition.
- Red reflective borders were installed on all speed limit signs throughout the City. This was completed for increased visibility of the sign.
- A large wooden pier was removed from the Cow Bayou waters with assistance from the Nassau Bay Volunteer Fire Department boat.
- Tree trimming completed along Upper Bay Road, Harbour Drive, Clippers Square, and the Clear Creek banks along David Braun Park.
- Memorial Day – American Flags were proudly displayed along Nasa Parkway and in the City.

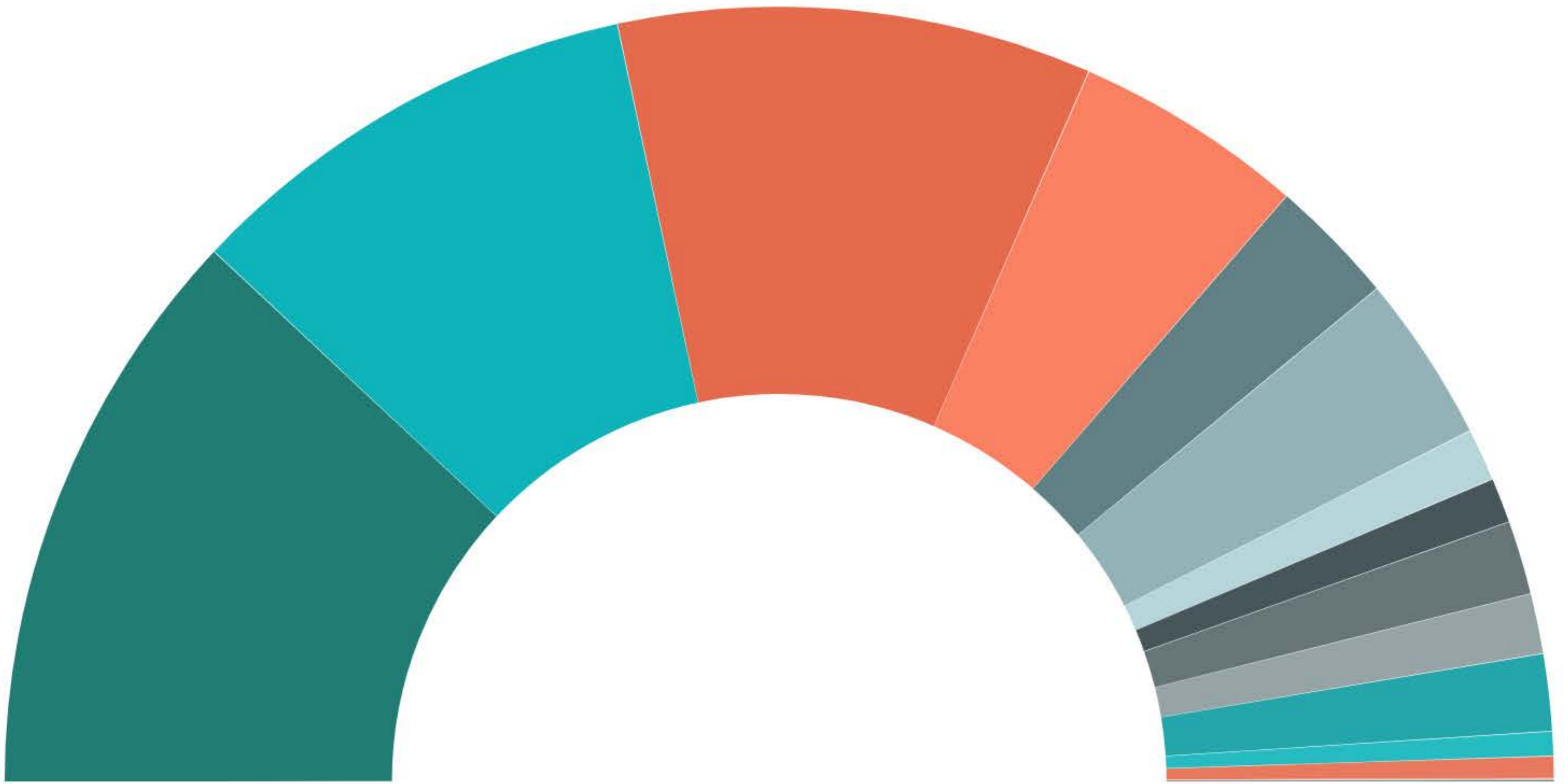
EMS Revenue Collected
