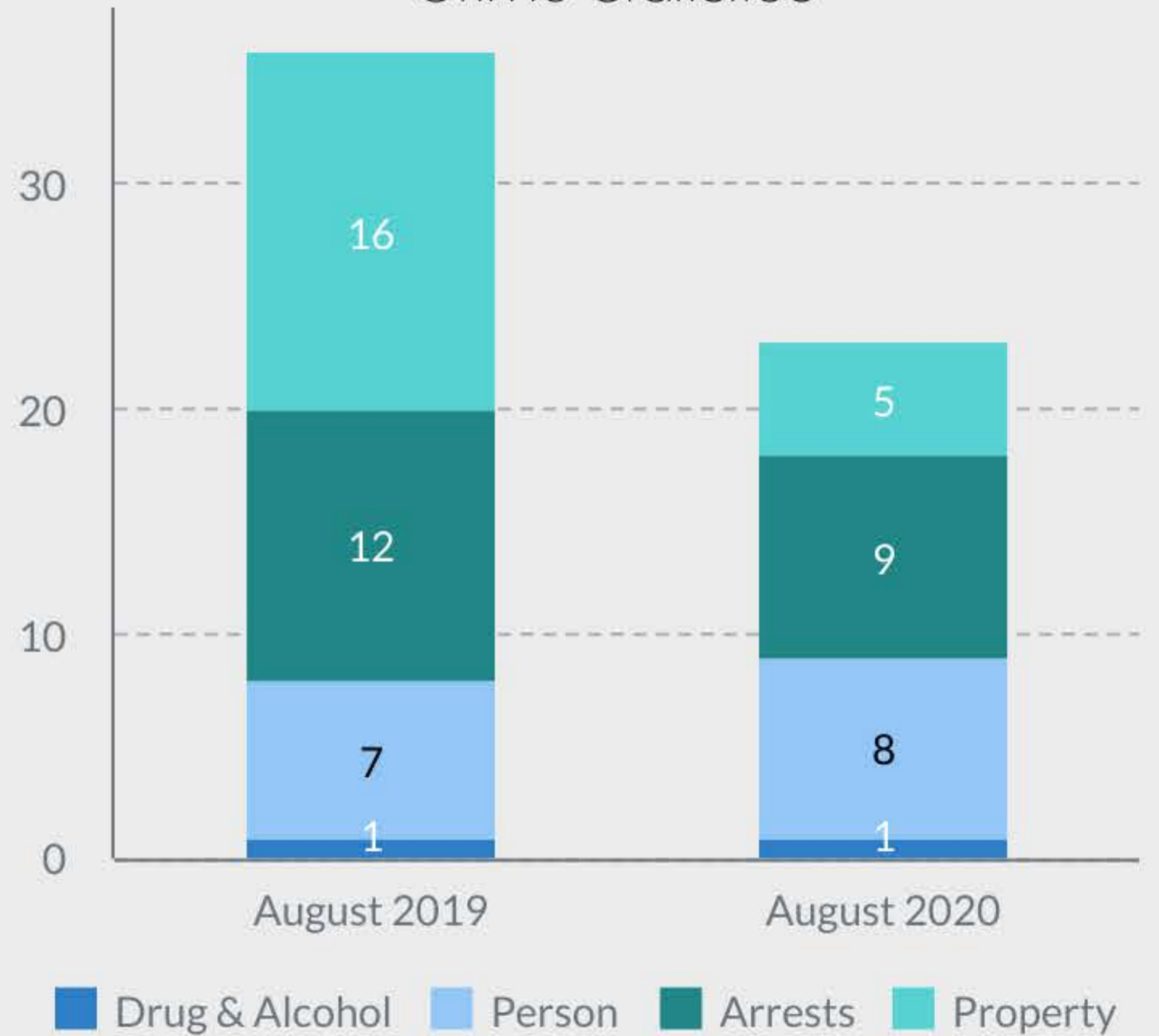

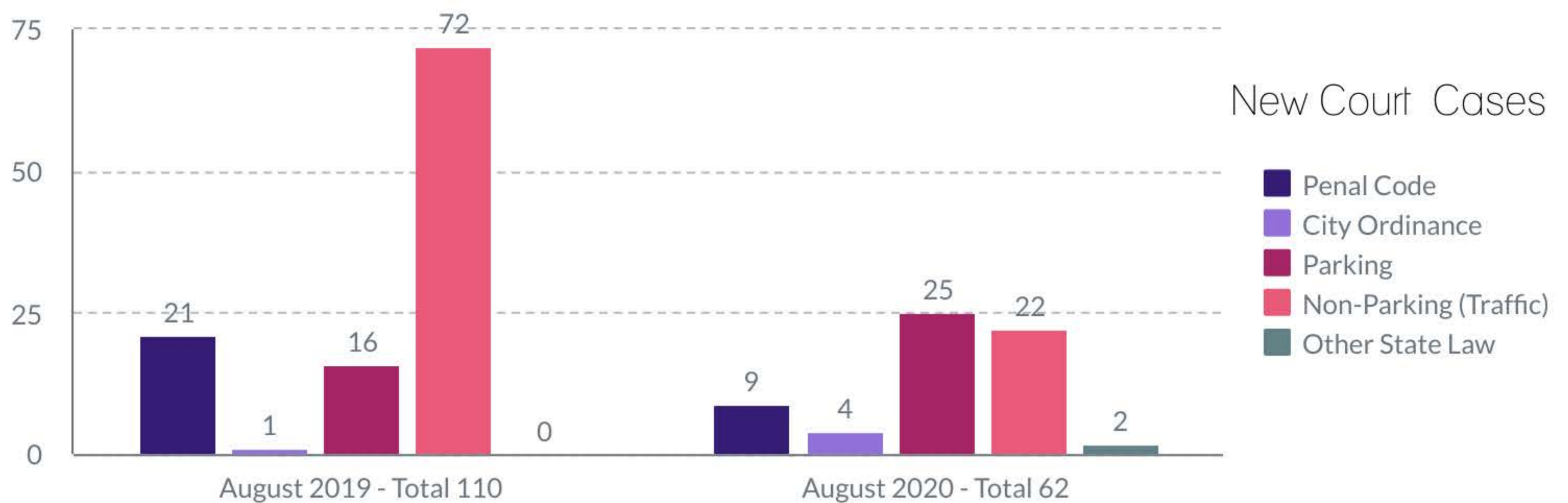

Calls for Service By Apartment



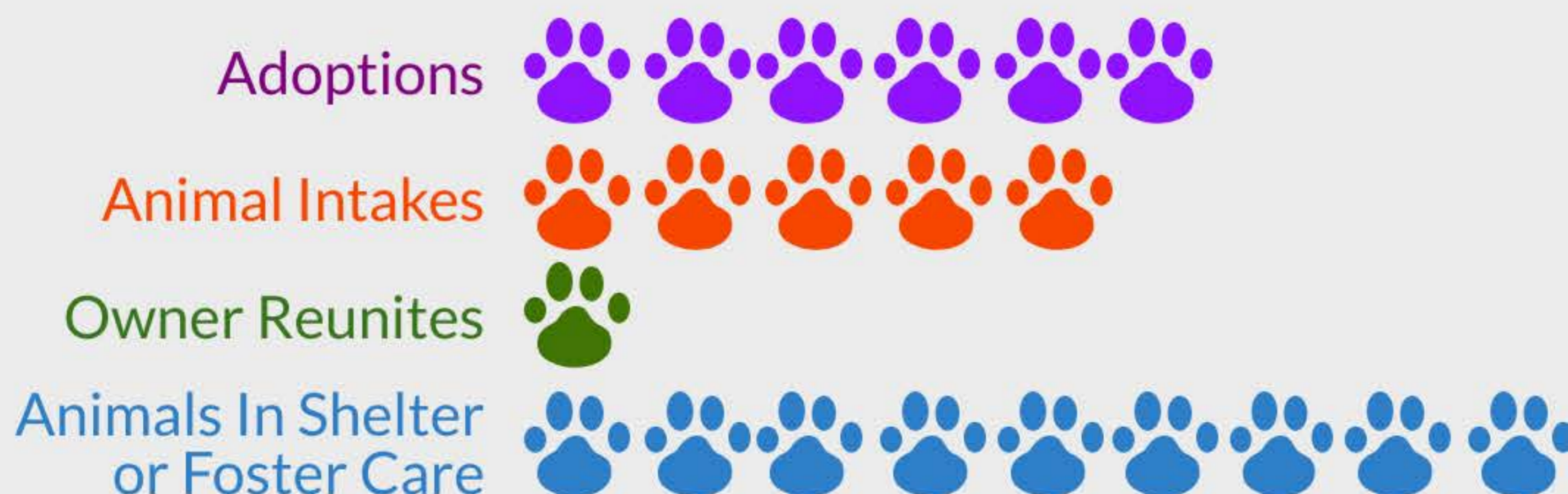

PUBLIC WORKS

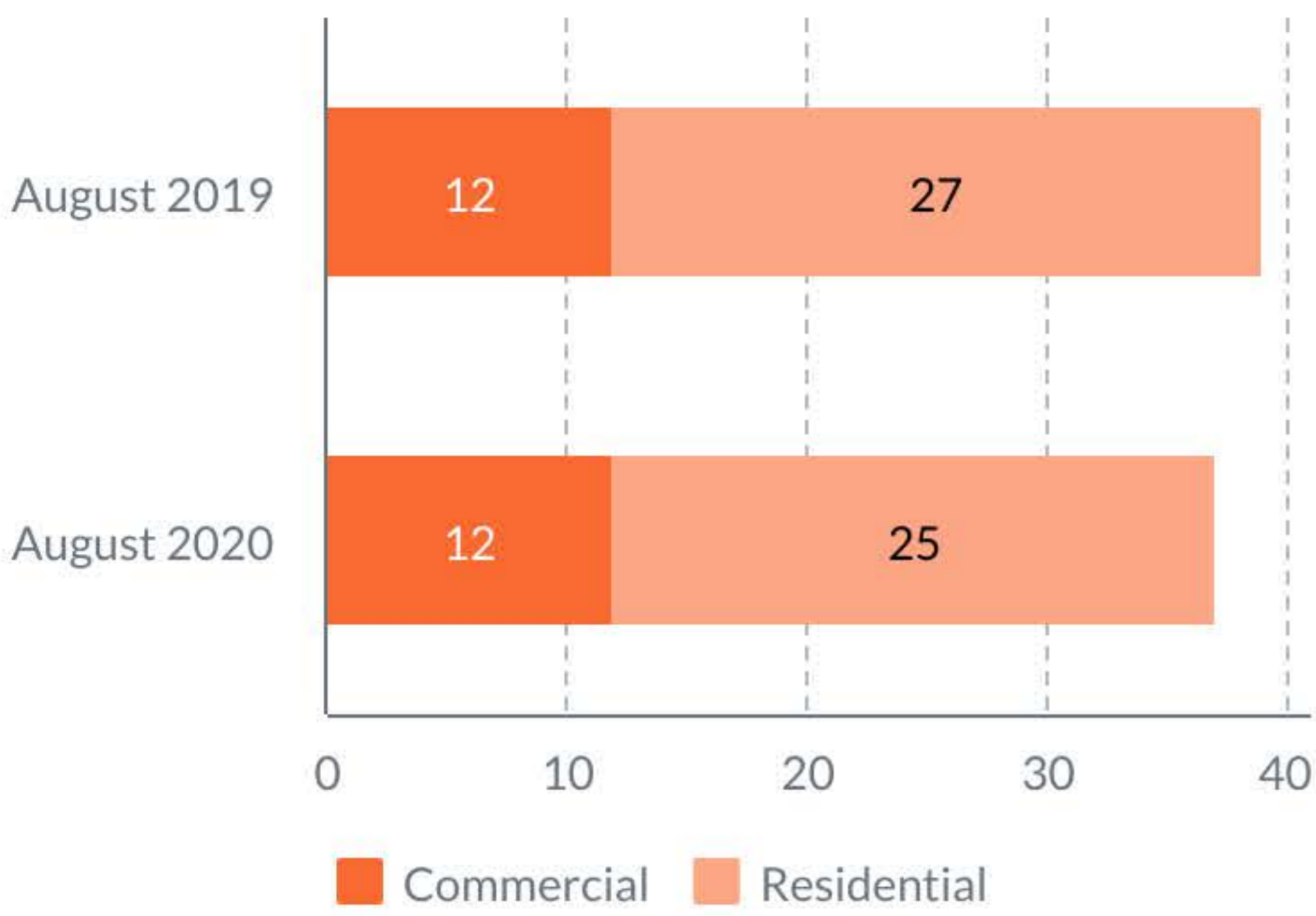
- Water Leak Repairs for the Month of August – Three (3) major leaks on the main line and two (2) service line repairs.
- Hurricane Laura – Staff prepared and mobilized equipment to high grounds, and prepared facilities for a direct hit.
- Previous Water Leaks – Sand and grass sod were installed at all previous water leak locations.
- Storm Line Jetting – Approximately 200 linear feet of storm line was jetted.
- Storm Water Street Projects Improvements – Street elevations were taken at Upper Bay and Port Royal.
- The CenterPoint streetlight project is completed. All streetlights are now operational.
- Sanitary Sewer Jetting – An estimated 500 linear feet was jetted to improve sewer flow.
- Storm Water Catch Basins Cleaned and Cleared of Debris During Rain Events – Two (2) times.
- Existing White Streetlights – Removal is in progress after the installation of the CenterPoint streetlights.
- Street brackets were installed at the intersections of the new CenterPoint streetlights.
- Harbour Drive Streets Lights – Lights are now operational after previous underground electrical issues.
- A palm tree was removed at the entrance of David Braun Park.
- Water meters were read for Utility Billing.
- An irrigation tap was completed at the 18700 block of Prince Williams.
- Monthly moving of the Peninsula was completed.
- Tree trimming around the City performed in between projects.
- Hedges and flower bed at the Upper Bay Circle and West Indies were trimmed and cleaned up.
- The Kingstree drainage easement is in the process of being cleared and trees trimmed.
- Reflection Garden at David Braun Park – Borders were installed and flower beds were cleaned.
- One Parks Maintenance employee, one Parks Maintenance / Asst. Animal Control Officer, and one Utility Maintenance employee were hired in Public Works.

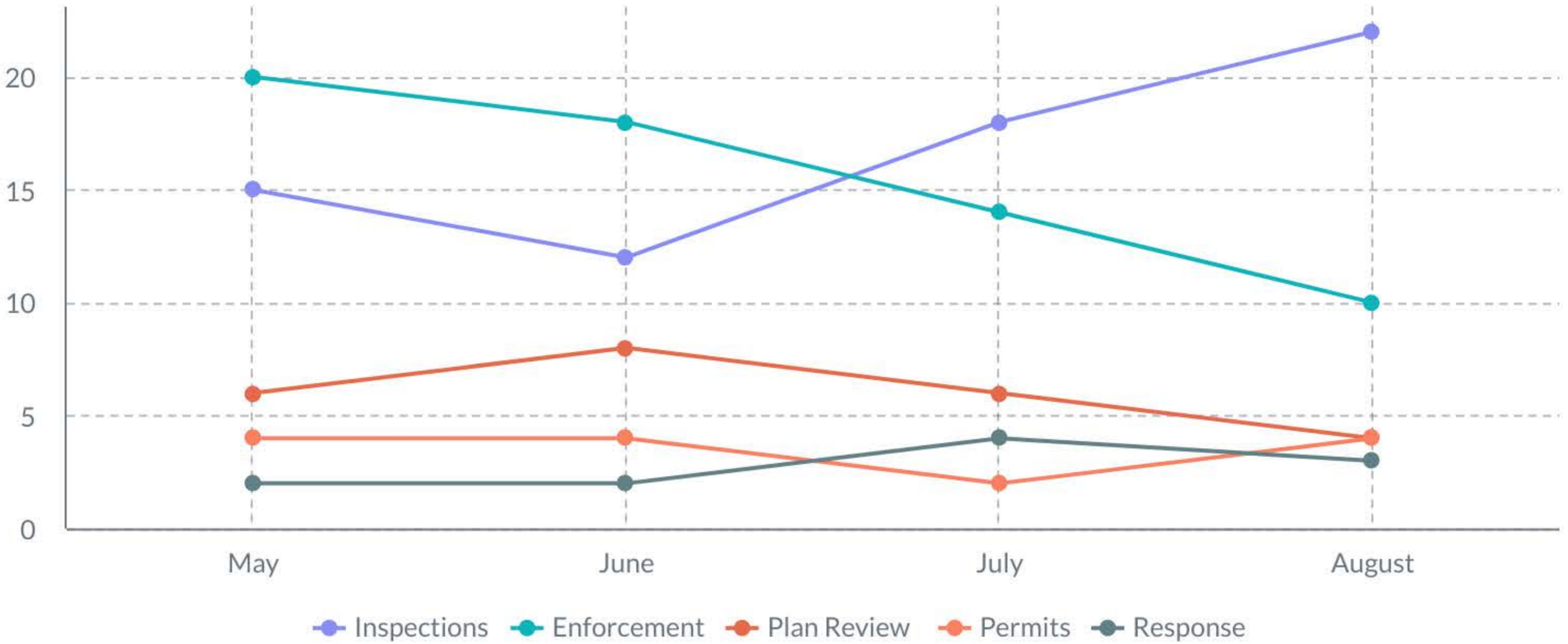

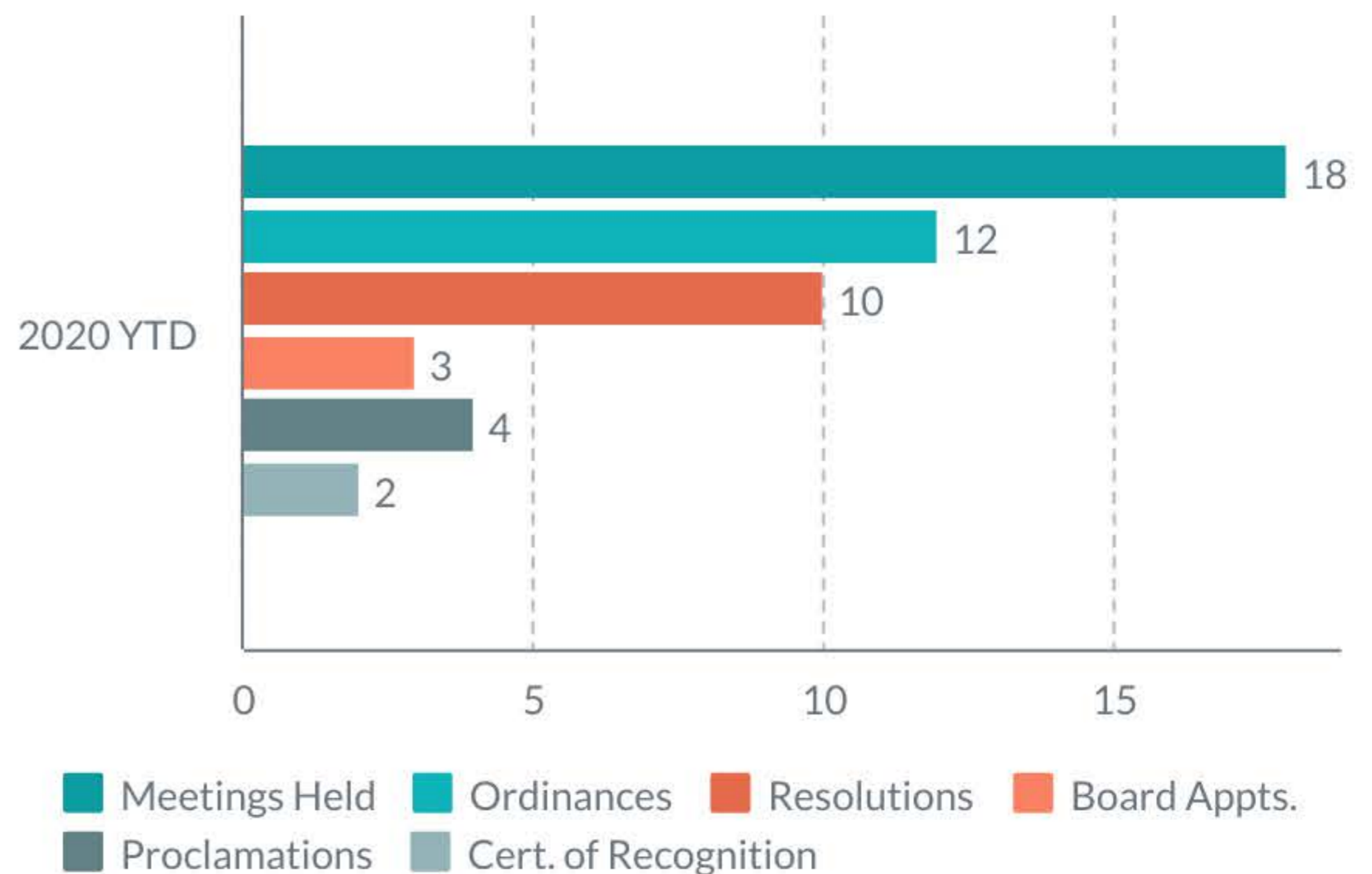

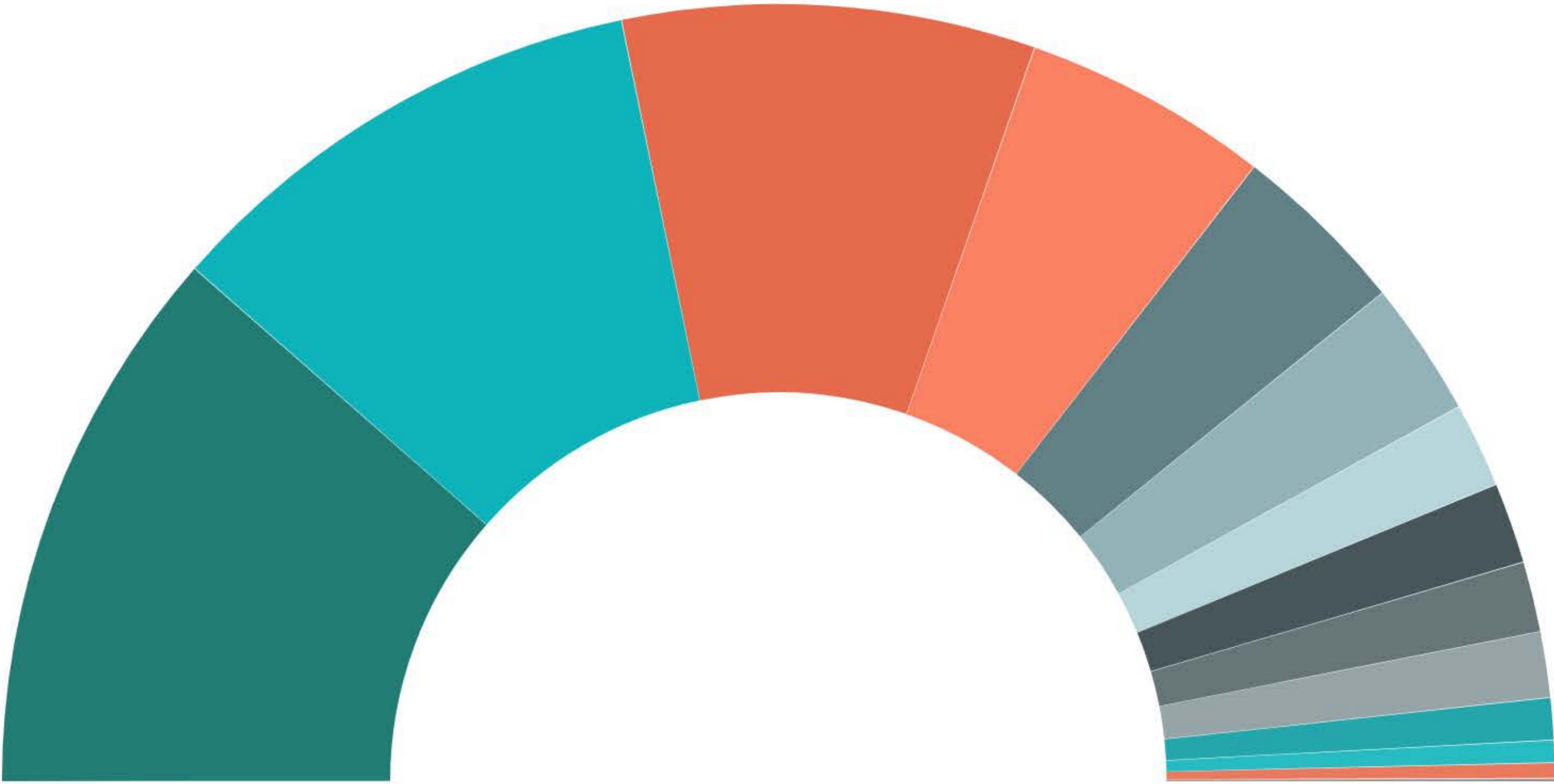
